#### NOTICE OF RACE

1. **Venue** the 2009 Saskatchewan Short Course championships will be held at Saskatoon Sailing Club, Redberry, SK. The Saskatoon Sailing Club and the Saskatchewan Sailing Clubs Association are the organisers of this event.
2. **Rules** The races will be governed by the current *Race Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association, the rules of international laser class association, ILCA.
3. **Eligibility** Each competitor must be a member in good standing in a club, which is currently in good standing with the CYA.
4. **Classes** Laser, Radial, Youth, Female, & Masters
5. **Schedule**

6. **Scoring.** The Low Point Scoring System, as described in Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing, will apply. 20 races are scheduled with no drop races of which one race must be completed to constitute a series. Races will be approximately 10-15 minutes in length. With minimal time between races
7. **Safety** All participants are required to wear a DOT approved PFD when on the water. Inspections will be conducted to insure that all boats comply.

8. **Entry Fee** No entry fee.
9. **Accommodations Hotel.** Camping is available
10. **CYA Discipline Code** it is expected that all athletes and coaches attending this event will respect and adhere to the CYA Discipline Code.
11. **Awards** Top three in all events will be awarded. A perpetual trophy to the top sailor in the Laser will be awarded. Plus “Long Drive” and the driftwood.
