NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of Sail Canada and the rules of the classes competing.

2. CLASSES The regatta is open to all classes of sailboats. If four or more boats register in one class, the race committee may endeavor to give that class a separate start. Other classes will race on handicap.

3. ENTRIES Entries will be accepted at registration at the clubhouse.

4. FEES

5. SCHEDULE

First warning signal	12:00	Saturday
Competitors' Meeting	09:00	Sunday at the clubhouse
First warning signal	10:00	Sunday

No warning signal will be made after 13:00 on Sunday.

PASC Classic Race—our traditional start for the first race on Sunday. All boats will start together and race on handicap. The race will still count for each class normally having its own start. The course will be announced at the Sunday Competitors' Meeting.

Nine races are scheduled, of which one must be sailed to constitute a series.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

7. SAFETY Approved PFD's must be worn at all times while on the water.

8 . PRESENTATIONS Sunday, as soon as possible after the last race.

9. HOSPITALITY

BARBECUE Saturday, approximately 18:30. Steak (\$15.00) or hamburger (\$8.00) dinner with salad, dessert and drink. Tickets will be available at registration.

CANTEEN Chili, coffee, soft drinks, baking and more will be sold in the clubhouse.

CAMPING Camping is available on club property, in designated areas only, please. Fires are permitted only in existing fire pits. Bring your own drinking water. Hotel rooms are available in nearby resort areas and Prince Albert.

BREAKFAST Sausages and pancakes on Sunday morning (\$4.00).
